About the University Student Survey

- Every year, the University of Greenwich conducts the University Student Survey with students in the UK and abroad
- The results are used by the University to improve the student experience for current and future students
- Results from overseas colleges are compared with those from students studying in the UK
- The results are used to inform University policy



Last year (2015) ...

- 1,856 students in the UK responded (25% response rate)
- 4,065 students overseas responded (32% response rate)

How the survey works

- The University of Greenwich sends relevant students an e-mail inviting you to take part
- This is sent to:
 - Your personal e-mail if you have supplied one
 - Else to your MSA e-mail if known (@msa.edu.eg)
 - Else to your University of Greenwich e-mail (@gre.ac.uk)
- The e-mail contains a unique link to your copy of the web-based questionnaire (using this link is the only way to do the survey)
- The questionnaire should take no more than 10-15 minutes to complete
