

**Students are required to submit a video presentation (e.g., PechaKucha or a similar narrative format). One student should submit the final work on behalf of the group.**

**\*Video title should contain your lab group, names and IDs in alphabetical order.**

**In a video of maximum 4 mins your team is required to the following criteria:**

- The video should start with a collective summarized **introduction** about your title and its importance for the customer, then at least **four** of the following information about each plant (according to the most attractive information to audience and your limited time):
  1. **Origin of the plant (including: part used, genus, species, family, Arabic and English names).**
  2. **Mention the role of each plant in the preparation (don't mention the brand name) and their benefits over the synthesized ones.**
  3. **Picture of the organ used from the plant (with the highest content of the main active constituent).**
  4. **Chemical constituents.**
  5. **Other uses of the plant.**
  6. **The mechanism of action of the main active constituent of the plant used in the preparation.**

**\*\*\*\*\*Make sure that voices and pictures are clear with the addition of these logos.**

**The five best Videos will get bonus marks.**

**Organization:** The video should have a clear beginning, middle and end.

**Grammar and Vocabulary:** English should be grammatically correct and scientific terms or acronyms can be used.

**Delivery and Narration:** Narration is clear, relaxed, comprehensible, has a good pace and consistent in style.

**Time:** video duration should be not less than 2mins and up to 4mins.
